CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE FOR JUNIOR TRAINING

- 1) Applicant must be at least 10 years old, or 9 years old and have successfully completed the SDC Taste of Sailing Opi Course and be a current member of Sutton Dinghy Club.
- 2) All applicants shall have the following swimming ability which comprises:
 - a) 25 metres swim
 - b) 2 minutes treading water
 - c) 10 seconds under water
 This may be tested and will be carried out in normal sailing clothes but without a life jacket.
- 3) Applicants are recommended to provide their own boat or to arrange a place on a boat. For those who do not have boats or a place in a boat the Club recommends that the sailor avail of a place on our Open Courses.
- 4) It is the responsibility of the boat owner/user to ensure that the boat has adequate insurance i.e. fully insured against third party and public liability claims.
- 5) Parents or adult family representatives are expected to assist in aspects of the shore-based activities of the course i.e. catering, tuck shop, slipway duty etc.
- 6) In the event of injury, parents of all trainees must accept that emergency treatment may be administered without possibility of prior consultation.
- 7) Parents/guardians of course participants give consent for photographic images to be used in information and publicity materials, and on the Sutton Dinghy Club and related websites.
- 8) Consent and waiver section of booking forms must be completed by parent/guardian.
- 9) All applicants must meet Course Prerequisites which can be viewed on the Members page at www.sdc.ie
- 10) Applicants undertake to comply with Sutton Dinghy Club's Code of Conduct. Available to view on www.sdc.ie on Policies & Procedures page

Similarly, I acknowledge that the Club, its trustees, officers, staff and members have no liability in respect of loss of life, injury or loss of or damage to property that my child or any other person may sustain arising from participation or intended participation howsoever arising.

If applicable, I confirm that my child's boat is insured against third party liability for a minimum of €1,300,000 to cover my liability regarding my child's participation on the course and for the period it is parked at the club. I also give consent for other students on the same sailing course as my child to use my child's boat.

If it becomes necessary for my child to receive medical treatment during the course, I hereby give my consent to any necessary medical treatment and authorise the Senior Instructor in charge or a member of the Sutton Dinghy Club management team to sign any document required by medical authorities.

I confirm that both I and the participant are willing to comply with Sutton Dinghy Club course regulations and have read and accept course-booking conditions.
