Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

Sunday 4th August 2019 - High Water Sutton: 15.09 hrs

INTRODUCTION

The Sutton Creek Races include starts from both Howth (for Puppeteer & Howth 17) and Clontarf (EBoat & Cruiser) to a Committee Boat finish adjacent to the Martello Tower off Sutton Creek.

ENTRIES & RACING

Boats as listed below under 'STARTS' are eligible to race. Racing will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing.

RESPONSIBILITY

Sutton Dinghy Club, its officers and agents accept no responsibility for any damage to boats or for personal injury occurring while afloat. Competitors' attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4, especially in relation to races being run in heavy weather.

MEMBERSHIP

All competitors will be granted honorary membership of the Club for the duration of the event.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fee is €10 per boat and can be paid on arrival in Sutton Dinghy Club or online via the Club website.

REFRESHMENTS

Refreshments will be available at Sutton Dinghy Club.

STORAGE OF BOATS

Sutton Dinghy Club accepts no responsibility for boats or property left on moorings or Club Property.

SAILING AREAS

The Sailing areas shall in North Dublin Bay in the vicinity of Sutton Dinghy Club and the Martello Tower.

Yachts sailing from Howth or Clontarf should keep their usage of the shipping channel to an absolute minimum. The Finish will be between an orange spherical buoy and the SDC Flagship 'Saoirse'.

Radio communication will be on Channel M (37A).
